Public policy engagement – scale of harm

- 117 496 gambling related suicides every year in England (OHID, 2023)
- 44% of people suffering 'problem gambling' classified as 'at high risk of suicidal behaviour' (YouGov for GambleAware, 2023)
- 35% increase in mortality associated with heavy gambling (Muggleton et al, 2021)



Public Policy Engagement – seat at the table for public policy

- National Suicide Prevention Strategy 2023 to 2028 published 11 September 2023 – now on the committee
- NICE Guideline 2025 Identification, assessment, and management of gambling related harms
- Health Select Committee letter to the Minister 2025



Legal - Inquest for Jack Ritchie 2022

- First large scale inquest into a sudden death involving gambling – Article 2 ECHR engaged
- Gambling led to Jack's death & treatment and information "woeful"
- Jack did not understand that gambling was not his fault
- System of gambling regulation not adequate to prevent Jack from gambling despite clear addiction
- PFDs issued to multiple government departments



Legal – Inquests Luke Ashton (2023)

- Gambling disorder recorded as medical cause of death
- Gambling operator had 'no meaningful interaction' with Luke – that might have prevented the death
- Action against the regulator pending
- Civil action against the operator pending



Legal – Current/future inquests

- 2025 4 inquests in progress with full legal funding looking at multiple systemic failures
- Gambling operators increasingly aggressive and try to allocate blame to the dead and the bereaved
- Gambling Commission reporting system for gambling suicides flawed and fails families

 Current Political ask – Investigation of every death and lessons learned **GwL Family Service Support**
